

Raymond M. Bergner, Ph.D. is professor of psychology at Illinois State University, and a psychotherapist with over 30 years experience in private practice. He is the author of two previous books and numerous articles in journals including *Psychotherapy*, *American Journal of Psychotherapy*, and *The Journal of Sex and Marital Therapy*. Dr. Bergner is a leading figure in the school of status dynamic therapy, a part of the intellectual discipline called Descriptive Psychology which grew up around the late Dr. Peter G. Ossorio in Boulder, Colorado. He is a founding member and past president of the Society for Descriptive Psychology, and co-editor of *Advances in Descriptive Psychology* Volumes 3, 6, 7 and 8.
